






How to find Valley Vista

Take the Coolac/Cootamundra turn off from the new Hume Freeway, turn left at the Coolac Pub and Valley Vista is about 200m on the left

On the 5th January 2022 we inspected the Valley Vista ram group. The goal of this is to provide a pre-sale fertility assessment of individual rams, so that their clients can be confident that rams purchased should be fertile, functional and ready to work. To our knowledge the protocol undertaken is leading the sheep seedstock industry in doing more rigorous fertility assessments as a baseline for all rams pre-sale.

Each ram is examined for several fertility traits, which have all been recorded with the rams individual ID and are available to buyers if needed. These traits include scrotal circumference, testicle tone and palpation of structures associated with the testicle, penis examination (which in general has not been practiced by industry to date), teeth assessment including jaw alignment, and leg and feet assessments.

Fertility assessment is a single point in time activity. The vendor has done everything possible to provide rams that are ready to work. However, we strongly advise that once the ram is home and settled, it is wise to check them before their first joining, and EVERY year 6-8 weeks pre-joining. A lot of work is expected of rams, and their functionality is paramount to your flock's fertility. They are a high value animal, but only if they are in working order. Please don't let them get over-fat, aim to keep them in body condition score 3, look after their feet, practice good biosecurity, be aware of Brucellosis risks, and have an accredited veterinarian assess their reproductive potential each year, so that EFFECTIVE rams are being put to work.

Ewe Family Breeding Lines

Valley Vista ewe family breeding lines are indicated by their swing-tag colour. Sires are written above the ewe ID number on swing tags, and are also listed in the catalogue.

Red

This is Valley Vista's Tattykeel based family, consisting of hire quality sires purchased over the years including TAT90-14, TAT222-04, TAT400-17 and most recently this year's \$32,000 purchase TAT274-20.

Green

Green is Valley Vista's oldest family line, based around the Armdale and Armdale Park bloodlines. Currently the most prominent sires in this family are VV138-14 (Fyfe) and VV38-09. This is our most dominant female breeding line, producing ewes that's progeny are standouts each year.

Purple

This Is our New Zealand connected family, consisting of NZ sire purchased Huntington 33-03 (Wombat) and sons we've retained of his.

White

White indicates the Valley Vista Park prefix, which contains a mixture of bloodlines; you can refer to their sire numbers on top of the dam ID swing tag for their connections. Lots of outcross genetics in this line.

Yellow

This line are daughters of Derrynock 33-18, who was purchased for \$19,000 and bred on with a focus on Lambplan ASBVs.

Orange

Orange are the Springwaters 250-17 (Taz), another new sire purchased and producing a new family line in recent years.

Joining Summary

All joined sale ewes were pregnancy scanned on Tuesday 21st December 2021, to lamb 1 April 2022 for one week. Ewes have been running with rams up until date of sale. Ewes will be scanned again the day prior to the sale and any updated information provided on the supplementary sheet.

TAT 274-20 (pictured): Purchased for \$32,000 from Tattykeel in 2021, powerful bodied sire with all the traits that the Poll Dorset breed needs. Has been used heavily in his first joining at Valley Vista, with over 150 lambs to be born in the first week of April. Great opportunity for other studs to tap into this impact sire.

Derrynock 33-18: Purchased for \$19,000 in 2019 for his high indexing LambPlan data, impressive growth PEMD, and overall index.

Geredan 108-03: A sire that came with the purchase of the Geredan stud ewes in 2007, this ram is a big, long bodied, deep carcass sire that played a huge role in the Geredan flock. Is a son of Geredan 101-01.



Kurralea 809-04 (Phoenix): Was purchased as part of the Geredan stud ewe deal, has bred exceptionally well at Valley Vista and used by many studs over the years. Has sired over 500 lambs at Valley Vista in his time.

Sire Summary

VV138-14 'FYFE': Another Son of the great VV38-09. Producing a very exceptional line of progeny. Supreme Poll Dorset Ram at AS&WS 2015.

Springwaters 66-16 (Pocock): Insert show history. Used as an AI sire to pack a punch, has bred deep carcase and heavy boned sons.

Springwaters 250-17 (Taz): Has been a very impressive Sire producing a stylish, fast maturing very sound line of offspring.

Tattykeel 400-17 (Martin): 1st June Drop Ram Australasian Dorset Championships. His line of sons in the sale will catch your eye and will suit both First-Cross and Merino operations.

VV58-17 (Mitchell): Champion Ram NSW Dorset Championships and Champion Ram Australian Sheep and Wool Show. A T90/14 son. A very impressive young sire that over the years we hope will breed a sought after line of sons for our clients.

Derrynock 33-18: Purchased for \$19,000 for his high indexing LambPlan data and impressive growth PEMD, and overall index.

VV493-18: One of Andrew's favourites bred at Valley Vista, very impressive structure and balance, with topline and clean points that the Poll Dorset industry is after.

VV64-18: Reserve junior champion at the Melbourne Royal as a lamb, which proves his early maturity and growth at a young age was impressive. A big, long ram.

Derrynock 12-18: Al sire. Used for his high PEMD (include HERE). Was Al'd to 50 ewes and has produced an impressive line-up of sons with early growth and high muscle.

Hillden 110-19: Al Sire. Insert show history. Has produced sons with presence and length, worked very well at Valley Vista at his first joining.

VV514-19: A son of TAT400-17, retained for structural correctness, this is his first crop of sons but keep an eye out over the years for many more as he has bred exceptionally well already. Low-birth weight sire.

VV493-19: By SW250-27, this is another low-birth weight sire. He's a clean pointed ram that has also bred exceptionally well in his first season at Valley Vista.

VV86-20: Retained sire from the 2020-drop, son of Derrynock 33-18. A high indexing fast growing sire that was used as a ram lamb and kept on at Valley Vista after impressive results in the Bowan Park trial and lambs on the ground at Valley Vista.

ASBVS and Indexes explained

What are ASBVs?

ASBVs are the units of measurement LAMBPLAN use to analyse animals. Australian Sheep Breeding Values are an estimate of an animal's true breeding value based on pedigree and performance recorded information. They are essentially a projection of how that animal's progeny will perform for a range of traits. Indexes combine important production traits into one number and are a useful way to rank animals quickly and easily.

ASBV types

Birth Weight (BW)

ASBV is based on measured birth weight of lambs adjusted for age of dam. Where birth weights are not available it is estimated as a correlated trait from weight measurements taken as the lamb matures. The lower the ASBV the lighter is the estimated progeny birth weight potential.

Weight (WWT) (PWWT)

ASBVs describe the animals' genetic merit for growth rate. A positive ASBV means the animal is genetically faster growing. Weight ASBVs are available for weaning (100 days), post-weaning (200 days), and yearling, hogget and adult ages.

Fat Depth (PFAT)

ASBVs describe the value of an animal's genes for fat depth at a constant weight – a negative ASBV means a genetically leaner animal.

Eye Muscle Depth (PEMD)

ASBVs describe the value of animals' genes for eye muscle depth at a constant weight – a positive ASBV means a genetically thicker muscled animal, and one that will have slightly more of its lean tissue in the higher-priced cuts.

TCP Index

The TCP index has been created to assist producers to achieve both gains in their major production traits, such as post-weaning weight and muscling, as well as ensuring consumer satisfaction from lamb is maintained through focusing on key eating quality traits such as shear force (tenderness) and intramuscular fat (marbling).



Ultrasonic Rib Eye Muscle Scanning In Live Sheep




Fig 1 - Exposed 12th rib on the carcase cut through the last thoracic

Meat Index

The meat index formula is based on the eye muscle width (A), eye muscle depth (B) and fat (C) measurements. A higher weighting is given to eye muscle width (A) because it is more heritable while eye muscle depth (B) is influenced by environmental factors. Fat (C) is penalised slightly. The resulting number is then adjusted for the age of the sheep to get an index.

NOTE:

- Current Live Weight = C/LW
- Eye Muscle Area (EMA) is calculated using the eye muscle width and eye muscle depth measurements.


